1 Corinthians 2:10-16

- 1) If Christianity is being rightly related to Christ and spirituality is being rightly related to the Holy Spirit, then can you explain the difference?
- 2) What does v.10 mean, that the Spirit has revealed to us the “depths of God”? (General revelation (2 Tim. 3:16), …specific revelation…).
- 3) Discuss together how it works (v.11-13); the Spirit of God as a medium, the believer as a receiver and a speaker.
- 4) In contrast (v.14), the natural man cannot discern the things of God. Do you see this evidenced around you? How do we tend to revert back to the natural man, and “words taught by human wisdom” (v.13)? In what areas are we vulnerable to this?
- 5) Can you tell of a time when you sensed God’s voice in your heart and saw it as a privilege (v15-16), to know the mind of Christ?
- 6) As a practical application to living a spiritual life, can you give examples of how the “take home” works:
 - a. Confess- Ps. 139:23-24
 - b. Wait on God- Isa. 40:31; Isa. 50:10-11
 - c. Listen- in prayer and with others and while reading scripture
 - d. Act- a bike in motion
