1 Corinthians 6:12-20

God's Designed Seal of Union

Thesis– Be very intentional about sex management because it is God's designed seal of union – trust, commitment and exclusivity.

Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20

- 1) V.12: What activities build you up (1 Cor. 10:23) and what things tear you down? What does it mean to be “mastered” by something?
- 2) How can you be more intentional about your time management so that you protect yourself and your marriage from getting run down?
- 3) Have you ever deprived yourself of something in order not to be in danger of being “mastered” by it? What has helped you in these experiences?
- 4) Is it a helpful reminder to you that your body belongs to God (see also v.19-20) and that God is there for you (your body)? How has that helped you in resisting the temptation to worship other things?
- 5) Read v. 15-17. What are your thoughts? Do you see that sex is a seal of union? Do you see how important it is to God that we keep ourselves from violating this union?
- 6) What are some practical ways we can protect ourselves from sexual immorality/adultery?
