COMMUNITY GROUPS

Community Group Member/Leader

(2-4hrs/Week) Community Groups allow us to connect with one another, share each other's burdens and truly explore what it means to follow Christ. Volunteer to help us with leadership events throughout the year or reach out to us if you would be interested in leading a community group.

COMMUNITY KIDS

Check-In Support (1 hr/month)
Tech friendly and service oriented people who assist families with checking in at 2 services each month.

Director of the Day

(4hrs/Month, 1 yr Commitment)
Provide support for Community Kids leaders and families at 2 services per month.

Elementary Small Group Leader

(4hrs/Month, 1 yr Commitment)
Guide kids into a deeper relationship
with God through activities,
discussion, prayer and fun at 2
services per month.

Nursery Caregiver

(4hrs/Month, 1 yr Commitment) Care for and love babies and toddlers at 2 services per month.

One-On-One Buddy

(2 hrs/month or As Needed)
Provide one-on-one support for a child during the service.

Preschool Leader

(4hrs/Month, 1 yr Commitment) Engage 2-6 year olds in Bible stories, games and art projects at 2 services per month.

Toy Cleaning or Curriculum Prep

(2-4hrs/Month)

Prepare materials for kids' classes or clean toys on a monthly basis during the week.

NOTE: Most positions also available at 1 Saturday service/month. (2hrs/Month)

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Baptismal Team (2x/year) Set up/tear down baptism pool two times per year.

Carenet & Hospitality Team

(As Needed/On Call)
Help provide meals and/or rides as needed that go beyond Community Group's capacity to help.

Cleaning Team (1-2x/month) Clean high touch areas upstairs and downstairs after each service.

Decor Team (Seasonal, as needed) Aids with choosing, setting up and tearing down decor for seasonal occasions and events.

Events Team (As Needed/On Call) Aids with setup and tear down of church-wide events and sometimes other ministry events when extra help is requested.

Main Entrace Greeters

Frontline Team (20-30min/Month) Assist with opening the main front doors to welcome guests.

Main Auditorium Ushers

Frontline Team (30min/month)
Greet guests, assist with seating, count and log service numbers.

Security (2 hrs/month) Complete security checks during services at one service per month.

Welcome Desk

Frontline Team (1hr/month)
Assist first time visitors before and after services, give welcome gifts, answer general CFC questions, help with connection card sign-ups and prayer requests.

MEN'S MINISTRY

Men's Ministry

Serve on our leadership team to create an environment at CFC that helps men pursue Christ and deepen their relationships with each other.

THE STUDENT COMMUNITY

GenNext /Jr High/Sr High Leaders

(Time Commitment Varies)
Be a key role in a young person's spiritual journey by building trusted relationships with students, loving students, leading intentional discussions, and celebrating spiritual growth in students' lives.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Women's Leadership & Volunteer Team

Plan and execute the necessary tasks to run Bible Studies, Mentoring Ministries, and Connection Events. Get plugged into areas of your giftings and passions. Opportunities include: teaching, registration, discipleship, hospitality, event planning, promotions and more.

WORSHIP ARTS

Arts: Cinematography Team

(As Needed/Project Based)
Storytellers with cameras. Join a team that supports the church through creative and artistic film projects designed to bring the gospel and the vision and mission of CFC to life through film.

Arts: Graphic Design Team

(As Needed/Project Based)
Design print and web materials for promotional and informational uses for the various events and ministries in the church.

Arts: Photography Team

(As Needed/Project Based)
Capture the moments that make up the life of our church for many different purposes and uses.
Some special projects and event assignments.

Instrumentalists & Vocalists

(1 Wknd/Month, 12-14hrs/Week) Vocalists and Instrumentalists who have a heart and desire for leading our church in songs of praise at weekend services and special events. Auditions required. Electric and Acoustic Guitar, Piano, Keys/Synth, Bass, Drums, Singers, string players, etc.

Livestream: Camera Operator

(1 Sunday/Month, 4hrs)
Operate one of our livestream cameras during Sunday services. Take cues from our Video Director and learn about Livestreaming tech and equipment. No experience necessary. Training provided.

Livestream: Video Director

(1 Sunday/Month, 4hrs)
Operate Livestreaming equipment including video switcher and livestream encoding program. Work in conjunction with the Weekend Service Producer and Camera Operators to facilitate the Livestream for weekend services. Some experience helpful but not necessary. Training is provided.

Production/Tech: Audio Engineer

(1 Wknd/4-6Wks, 8hrs/Wknd) General audio engineering and mixing for weekend services and special events. Requires some experience. Training is involved.

Production/Tech: Lighting

(1 Wknd/month, 8hrs/Wknd) Lighting design and engineering for weekend services and special events. Training provided.

Production/Tech: Media Computer

(1 Wknd/Month, 8hrs/Wknd)
Operate the slideshow presentation software for weekend services and special events. No experience necessary. Training provided.

Production/Tech: Service Producer

(1 Sunday/Month, 4hrs)
Coordinator, main fascilitator
and point person for Weekend
Services. Work in conjunction with
the Livestream Video Director to
coordinate the Weekend Service flow,
troubleshoot issues and communicate
across teams. Provide guidance and
direction for Production Team during
services. No experience necessary.
Training provided.

NOTE: Some volunteer opportunities at CFC require specific spiritual gifts and further interview processes.
