Hebrews 10:24-25

- **24** And let us consider how we may <u>spur</u> one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
- 1. "Spur" (paroxusmos) to jab; incitement to good or dispute in anger. (Strong's Concordance). Discuss an experience you have had in "spurring" someone else towards love and good deeds.
- 2. Discuss saving faith and works based on these two passages.

Eph. 2:8-10

For by grace you have been <u>saved</u> through <u>faith</u>. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, *<u>not a result of works [of the law]</u>, so that no one may boast. **For we are his <u>workmanship</u>, <u>created</u> in Christ Jesus <u>for good works [of love]</u>, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

James 2:14 & 17
