Compassion International

Pray for Compassion families who were affected by flooding and fires. Pray for strength and community as they lean on others and rebuild what was lost. Also pray that they would feel God's comfort and provision through a time when they have lost so much.

Hope International

We pray, Lord, for the HOPE network as the human resources team seeks to fill several open positions.

As Burundi suffers from a recent surge in malaria, we pray that You, God, would bring healing and that those impacted would trust You and feel Your presence.

God, we pray for the Batwa, a historically marginalized ethnic group in Burundi. We pray that HOPE's church partners in Burundi would have confidence as they seek to serve this group and proclaim the Gospel, and we pray that You would continue to give Burundian churches boldness to reach the Batwa and other marginalized communities in Burundi.

We pray that HOPE Ukraine would trust You, Lord, as it seeks to connect with new savings group members among the Roma, a historically nomadic community that continues to be marginalized. We pray that You would strengthen the team and lead them as they provide financial services among underserved communities.

Please continue praying for the church's involvement in the work of justice and restoration in El Salvador. Pray that many congregations and parishes will partner with our team and take concrete steps to build safe spaces for victims and survivors of violence against women and children in their communities. Pray specifically for God to pour His strength, courage, compassion and commitment upon them so many can be protected and restored.

Praise God for the successful arrest of a powerful woman who repeatedly trafficked teen girls for sex. Police had been searching for her since 2017, when a rescued victim shared how this woman trafficked her and dozens of others across the country into her network of brothels. IJM supported the investigation for the last five months and helped police finally pinpoint this woman's location, leading to her arrest. Pray she would finally be held accountable for her crimes in court, and that other criminals would see this case as an example of the power of the law.

Praise God for another conviction in the Philippines! A young woman in Metro Cebu pled guilty to attempted trafficking in persons and possession of child pornography. She was arrested last December by agents from the Philippine National Bureau of Investigations. In the same police operation, five

children, ranging from six to 15 years old, were rescued. Join us in thanking God for justice on behalf of these victims and asking Him to work in the life of this young woman as she serves her sentence.

Immerse

2. Pray for one more international student for our residence hall (female).
3. Ask God to bring in the additional funds needed for the "Bridge the Gap" refugee program.

5. Pray for our team that we will journey deep with God and journey deep with those we serve.
