## Study Guide Leviticus | I Belong

1. Burnt Offering (Lev. 1; 6:8-13)- I Need to Worship

Read Leviticus 1:1-10. Discuss the concept of the burnt offering. What was it? Discuss the various aspects and their meaning:

- a. Voluntary
- b. Costly
- c. Atonement
- d. The sprinkling of life-blood
- e. Cut into pieces and laid bare
- f. Fntrails washed
- g. Offering was consumed
- h. A sweet-smelling savor
- 2. Discuss these concepts:
- a. I will be consumed by something
- b. We worship what we love
- c. We serve what we worship
- 3. What might God be asking me to offer up as a "burnt" offering (Psalm 51:16-17; Romans 12:1)? How does the sacrifice of Christ (Eph. 5:2) help me to trust Him?
- 4. Grain Offering (Lev. 2; 6:14-18) I Need to Depend How can we learn to depend more on Christ for our daily needs?
- 5. Peace Offering (Lev. 3; 7:11-34) I Need to be Known

Read Ephesians 2:13-14. What did Christ do for us, and why did He do it?

Discuss the concept of the fellowship/peace offering in conjunction with a meal. What does it foster when people have a meal together?

How can we better foster knowing and being known by God and others?

### 1. Burnt Offerings (Lev. 1; 6:8-13) Leviticus 1:1-10

"The Lord called to Moses and spoke to him from the tent of meeting. He said, "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'When anyone among you brings an offering to the Lord, bring as your offering an animal from either the herd or the flock. "If the offering is a burnt offering from the herd, you are to offer a male without defect. You must present it at the entrance to the tent of meeting so that it will be acceptable to the Lord. You are to lay your hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on your behalf to make atonement for you. You are to slaughter the young bull before the Lord, and then Aaron's sons the priests shall bring the blood and splash it against the sides of the altar at the entrance to the tent of meeting. You are to skin the burnt offering and cut it into pieces. The sons of Aaron the priest are to put fire on the altar and arrange wood on the fire. Then Aaron's sons the priests shall arrange the pieces, including the head and the fat, on the wood that is burning on the altar. You are to wash the internal organs and the legs with water, and the priest is to burn all of it on the altar. It is a burnt offering, a food offering, an aroma pleasing to the Lord."

### What is really behind the burnt offering?

Psalm 51:16-17

"You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a <u>broken</u> and <u>contrite heart</u> you, God, will not despise."

### 2. Grain Offering (Lev. 2; 6:14-18) I Need to Depend

"When anyone brings a grain offering to the Lord, their offering is to be of the finest flour. They are to pour olive oil on it, put incense on it and take it to Aaron's sons the priests." Lev. 2:1

## 3. Peace Offering (Lev. 3; 7:11-34) I Need to be Known

Lev. 3:1 "If your offering is a fellowship offering, and you offer an animal from the herd, whether male or female, you are to present before the Lord an animal without defect."

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The Meal

Lev. 7:15 "And the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings for thanksgiving shall be <u>eaten</u> on the day of his offering."

## Peace Offering- I need to be known

Eph. 2:13-14

<sup>-</sup>But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For he himself is <u>our peace</u>, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility..."
