Jonah | The Epilogue

As we close out Jonah and launch into our month of serving at CFC who is God calling you to? What is God calling you to do?

1. How does God speak to you? In Acts 9:3-4 God brings a bright light to Saul that literally blinds him. In what ways and through what avenues does he speak to you.
2. God then uses a change in circumstances to Saul (blindness) to get his attention. As he continues to pursue Saul to live out the calling in his life He also pursues you to live out your calling. Is God working through changes in your circumstances and are you listening?
3. Ananias has no idea that God is already working in the heart and goes before him to Saul. What kind of courage and excitement would this give you to know that God is working in the life of the person or people that he is calling you to?
4. Go! Incredible words. Get moving. What action items might you take to go to the one or the people that God is calling you to be the mouthpiece of Him to?
5. How must have Ananias felt to see the response of Saul and how God used him? How would this make you feel to see God use someone that He used you as his mouthpiece to reach?
