

Study Guide

Leviticus

There are a lot of options here. I recommend choosing 2 or 3 to discuss.

1. How has the culture we live in in 21st century America shaped our beliefs, attitudes, priorities and behaviors? How do we struggle to accept God's revealed will in areas of life like our relationships with others, our marriages and families, wealth, sexuality, how we spend our time and any other areas the group may identify?
2. Discuss the idea that we can't have healthy relationships with others if we're not aware of their values, likes and dislikes, attitudes and beliefs. How has the process of finding these things out about another person contributed to the health of your marriage, friendships and other key relationships?
3. What do we see revealed regarding the heart of God and his values and priorities, in the moral law he gave to his people Israel in Leviticus 18 and 19?
4. Read Ephesians 5:8-17. What does Paul mean when he says in Ephesians 5:10 "find out what pleases the Lord"? How are you as an individual or as a group doing regarding finding out what pleases the Lord? How can we do a better job with this?
5. Study some of the key differences between the Old Covenant God made with Israel through Moses and the New Covenant God has made with us through the Lord Jesus Christ. (This may require assigning this study to someone who can lead a discussion around the topic.)
6. Discuss the connection between Love and Obedience in our relationship with the Lord. Examine the following scriptures:
 - John 14 verses 15, 21, and 23-24.
 - John 15:10
 - I John 2:3-6
 - I John 3:21-24
 - I John 5:3
 - Luke 6:46-49
 - Matthew 7:21-23
7. Discuss the idea of putting off the old nature and putting on the new nature using scriptures such as Ephesians 4:1-6 and Colossians 3:1-14.
8. How can we better live out the first and second greatest commandments as summarized by Jesus in Matthew 22:24-30?
