Matthew 1:18-25

1. Discuss why the virgin birth is so central to our Christian faith.

Matthew 1:18- *"Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit."*

Luke 1:35- *"And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God."*

2. Read Matthew 1:19-20a:

"And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. ²⁰But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream...

What must Joseph have felt when he found out that Mary was pregnant? Describe a time when your world was rocked and you had a sleepless night. What was that like for you?

3. Read Matthew 1:20b-21:

"Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

Can you think of a time when the voice of God became a calming presence in your life?

4. Read Matthew 1:22-23:

"All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: ²³'Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel'" (which means, God with us)."

How can the promises of God offer us peace with unanswered questions? What does it mean to you, that "God is with us.- Immanuel"?

5. Read Matthew 1:24-25

"When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, ²⁵but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus."

Joseph let go...

1. ...of what others would think of him (shame)
2. ...of law and punishment (performance)
3. ...of what life "should" be like.
