5. How did it make you feel to read The Kingdom New Testament translation of Philippians 2:3? "Never act out of selfish ambition or vanity; instead, regard everybody else as your superior. Look after each other's best interests, not your own"
6. What person or group of persons do you struggle most with regarding as "your superior" in Christ? How can you give up power (as Paul describes of Christ in Philippians 2.5-8) to serve someone else?
7. What is one thing you need to change about your way of life to disentangle it from this world and connect it more closely (worthy) to Jesus the king?
