Ephesians 4:11-12

“And he gave some apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ.”

1. What were your thoughts from the sermon? What do you think God wants us as the Body of Christ to be doing?

2. What did Apostles and Prophets do to lay the foundation of the church (Eph. 2:20; Eph. 3:5; 2 Cor. 12:11b-12)? What could be the functions of apostles and prophets today in equipping the church?

Example:

1 Cor. 14:1- *“Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.”*

3. Evangelists have a unique gift of communicating the good news in relevant terms. However, all believers are called to evangelism, the *“ministry of reconciliation.”* (2 Cor. 5:18). How can people with the gift of evangelism, help others in the church to be equipped to share their faith?

4. Shepherd/Teachers are gifted by God to care for and teach the “flock”. (1 Pet. 5:2; John 21:17). How can they help others in the church to be equipped to do works of ministry? How can this equipping happen in the context of Community Groups and Congregational led ministries?

5. Where do you see yourself in the process of equipping each other? Do you need to be equipped, or are you currently equipping someone else for ministry?

A. Apostles and Prophets

1. Laid foundations

“...built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the cornerstone.”

2. Declared Revelations

Ephesians 3:5

“...not made known ... in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.”

3. Gave Confirmation

2 Corinthians 12:11b-12

For I was not at all inferior to these super-apostles, even though I am nothing.”The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with utmost patience, with signs and wonders and mighty works.

Prophecy

B. Evangelists- Bearers of good news.

John 21:17 “Feed my sheep.” (*Teach*)
