1. Read verse 1. What are the ways you envision Paul laboring for the people in prison? Who do you feel like in your life labors over you? Is there anyone that you are currently praying for in this way?
2. Read verses 2-5. What are the ways that Paul gives us to strengthen us and those around us? How does he encourage us to walk? What is one that jumps out to you or challenges you the most?
 - a. How do these 5 things not only encourage and remind us but also speak to the world around us?
3. Read verse 6-7. What does it mean to walk in Christ to you? When we know that Christ is over our walk and that His plan greater how does that give us freedom?
4. Your walk in Christ will always reflect your intimacy with Him. Where does your intimacy need to be deepened? Spend a few minutes in prayer asking God to deepen your intimacy with Him. To help you drive your roots deep in Him.
