Hearing God's Voice Study Guide

1. Read 1 Samuel 3:8-10. Share on a scale of 1-5 (a little to a lot), of how open you are to

hearing God speak to you. Why did you choose that number? Discuss.

2. God speaks in a variety of ways: Conscience, Prayer, Meditation, Creation, the written Word, circumstances, silence, suffering, other people, angelic visitation, dreams, visions, miracles, an audible voice, a still voice. Share a time when God spoke to you in one of these ways.

3. God speaks through the written word! What has been your experience in hearing God speak to you through His word. How would you 'coach' somebody to hearing from God through His word? Discuss.

4. God speaks through other people. Share a time when God spoke to you through another person. What was that like? Do you ever think that God speaks through you to others? What can you do to be more open and 'in tune' to that? Discuss.

5. God speaks through His voice. The Bible has examples of the audible voice of God speaking to a person. Have you ever lived in insecurity because you have not heard God's audible voice? Remember how much God loves you as a Father and desires to be in relationship with you. Instead of the audible voice, He does speak to you! How do you tend to hear God? Discuss:

-Knowers: you just know it, and you don't really know how

-See-ers: You can just see what something is going to be before it happens. -Hearers: You get a faint whisper in your mind where God gives you a play by play of what will be.

-Feelers: You get a sense of something. Peace settles on you; or you get a sense that something is bad.

Application

Take a few minutes to pray as a group that God will help you to hear and discern what He is saying to you this next week.
