### Sermon Notes | The Parable of the Talents - Matthew 25:14-30

**Big Idea:** Be faithful with what God has given you.

1. God Has Made You a Manager

"For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property." (v.14)

- God entrusts us with:
  - **Spiritual possessions** (Holy Spirit, gospel, spiritual gifts)
  - **Physical possessions** (time, talent, treasures)
  - Relational possessions

"You are not your own, for you were bought with a price." (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

2. You Must Be Faithful with What You Have

"He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them, and he made five talents more." (vv.16–17)

• Faithfulness is the goal, not output.

"Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master." (v.21)

• Faithful stewardship requires **eagerness**, **risk**, **and obedience**.

#### 3. Your Management Will Be Evaluated

"But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant!... You ought to have invested my money with the bankers." (vv.26–27)

- Your effort reveals your heart.
- Neglecting God's gifts results in loss.

"For to everyone who has will more be given... But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away." (vv.29–30)

• God will reward faithful servants.

"Enter into the joy of your master." (v.21)
