I. The Promise of Life (v.1)

II. Be in Christ (1-2)

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, according to the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus, ²to Timothy, my dear son: Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

III. Be Sincere (v.3-5)

³I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a **clear conscience**, as I remember you constantly in my **prayers** night and day. ⁴As I remember your tears, I **long to see you**, that I may be filled with joy. ⁵I am reminded of your **sincere faith**, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well.

Study Guide | **Multiply: Fearless** - January 2025 2 Timothy 1:1-7

1. Share any initial thoughts from the service.

What does the "promise of life" (v.1) mean to Paul, when he had experienced persecution and was facing execution? How have you seen God provide you with "life" now already, and not just in the afterlife? Discuss.

2. Our key verse for this series is 2 Tim. 2:2:

"And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others."

Discuss your personal experiences with discipleship. Did someone mentor you? What were some of the things you learned?

- 3. Read 2 Tim. 1:1-7. Discuss the following:
 - a. What does it mean to be endearing to people as Paul was to Timothy?
 - b. What does it mean to be in Christ? (see also Gal. 2:20)
 - c. What does it mean to have a cleansed conscience (v. 3-5)?
 - d. What do you think are your spiritual gifts (v. 6-7)? Do others agree?
- 4. Read 2 Tim. 1:7 again. Discuss how the Holy Spirit can help you be less fearful and more filled with "power, love and a sound mind."

Pray for each other: to be unafraid, intentional, willing to sacrifice, sincere and filled with the Holy Spirit.
