## Study Guide Numbers 32

Big Idea: It's not about the cows, but a kingdom!

"York and Lancaster have a shared history, to be sure, but a relationship that has since faced a milewide barrier: the Susquehanna River." York Daily Record, April 18, 2023

Several tribes of Israel want to remain on the eastside of the river. It's a better place for livestock. That's make sense right? Well, when we dig a little, we find out that the river creates a barrier and disunity. We soon realize it's not about the cows but a kingdom.

- 1. To See: Read Numbers 32:1-5. Discuss the concept that we become what we behold. (see also Genesis 3:6; Genesis 13:10).
- 2. To Sit: Read Numbers 32:6-9. Why do you think this proposal was a discouragement to the others? Share a time when you felt discouraged by the lack of commitment from someone you depended on.
- 3. To Stop Wholly Following God: Read Numbers 32:10-15. It was interesting that the sin of self-indulgence and unbrotherliness, had led the group to the brink of destruction in the past. Now it seemed like it could happen again (v. 15). How can we be more intentional to "wholly follow the Lord" like Joshua and Caleb? (see also 2 Peter 1:3-8).
- 4. To Be Sidelined: According to Numbers 32:16+ it seems like they found a solution. Help with the war and then go back across the river. Notice that there was no addressing of the core issue (not wholly following God), and that in the future (Joshua 22 and Luke 8), that region was no longer really a part of Israel.

### A. To See (Numbers 32:2-5)

<sup>2</sup> So the people of Gad and the people of Reuben came and said to Moses..."the land that the Lord struck down before the congregation of Israel, is a land for livestock, and your servants have livestock." <sup>5</sup> And they said, "If we have found favor in your sight, let this land be given to your servants for a possession. Do not take us across the Jordan."

## C. To Stop Following God (Numbers 32:10-15)

<sup>10</sup> And the Lord's anger was kindled on that day, and he swore, saying, <sup>11</sup> 'Surely none of the men who came up out of Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, shall see the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, because they have not wholly followed me, <sup>12</sup> none except Caleb ... and Joshua..., for they have wholly followed the Lord.'... <sup>14</sup> And behold, you have risen in your fathers' place, a brood of sinful men, to increase still more the fierce anger of the Lord against Israel! <sup>15</sup> For if you turn away from following him, he will again abandon them in the wilderness, and you will destroy all this people."
