Small Group Questions:

- 1) Where do you typically go to seek wisdom?
- 2) What role does God's Word play in your seeking of wisdom?
- 3) Read Romans 12:1-2, God seems to lay out a path (not prescription) for discerning His will. Consider the relationship between these key phrases: "...God's mercy... living sacrifice... not conform[ing]... be[ing] transformed... test and approve what God's will is..." From this passage, where are you challenged and encouraged in your faith journey? Explain.
- 4) In the sermon we talked about (1) listening to the Lord, (2) beginning to act on something that He may be prompting you to do, and (3) listen again and repeat. What doors that the Lord may want you to push on as you continue to walk with Him? If you have an answer, share it with your small group and ask these friends to check in on your progress.






